About four hundred delegates appeared and took their seats in the Bleecker street church, at 10 o'clock A. M. The throne of grace was addressed by the Rev. Caleb Green, of Stillwater. Dr. Hiram Corliss, Vice President, from Washington County, was called to the chair, to preside over the deliberations of the meeting, assisted by Col. Reuben Sleeper, Vice President, from Livingston County, and Samuel Lightbody, Vice President, from Oneida County, and Wm. Green, Jr., Vice President, from New York. Select portions of Scripture were read by Rev. A. Savage of Utica. On motion, a Committee of three was appointed to nominate Secretaries, consisting of A. Stewart, Rev. A. Savage, and William Goodell, who reported the names of Josiah Andrews of Genessee, Co., P. V. Kellogg of Oneida Co., and R. G. Williams of New York,...
